Vessel Cut-Over Lists

Contact Information

As soon as a CP Ships service has been transferred to Hapag-Lloyd, you should approach your new Hapag-Lloyd contact for all of your business requirements relating to this service. As a customer located in a region that is not or only little affected by Phase One, please continue to contact your current CP Ships office. Contact details for all services of Phase Two will be provided to you in the next edition of the Customer News.

Business Procedures

You will encounter little or no differences between the Hapag-Lloyd and the CP Ships business procedures. As soon as a CP Ships service has been transferred to Hapag-Lloyd, all bookings and transport documentation will be handled by Hapag-Lloyd. You will then receive Bills of Lading and invoices for

consignments booked with Hapag-Lloyd from Hapag-Lloyd.

Supply Chain Security

Both Hapag-Lloyd and CP Ships strongly support worldwide efforts to make the supply chain more secure.

Hapag-Lloyd and CP Ships are members of the voluntary C-TPAT (Customs-Trade Partnership Against Terrorism) and our vessels comply with the ISPS-Code (International Ships and Port Security Code).

Carrier and Terminal Security Fee

These security-related requirements have had a cost impact on ocean carriers and terminal facility operators. The Hapag-Lloyd [website](#) provides an overview of our Carrier Security Fee and several Terminal Security Fees.



24 Hours Rule for USA and Canada

Hapag-Lloyd and CP Ships comply with the 24 Hours Advance Manifesting Rules of the United States and Canada.

The relevant documentation closing dates will be printed on your booking confirmation and can be found in the interactive schedule section of the Hapag-Lloyd website under details for the specified port of loading.

Information for Self-Fileers

For AMS:

- Our SCAC-Code is: HLCU
- Please include our SCAC Code in your AMS filings as well as our Master Bill of Lading Number, which will be provided to you with our booking confirmation.

For ACI:

- Our 9000-Series Code is: 9529
- Our Cargo Control Number (CCN) Number consists of:
BI – Carrier Code + **OB** – Bill of Lading

For Hapag-Lloyd: **BI** = **9529**, **OB** = (ocean bill) – the **B/L** number **without** the HLCU prefix.

High Security Seal

To comply with US regulations, USA destined containers have to be sealed with High Security Seals as per ISO PAS 17712. In the interest of improved supply chain security, Hapag-Lloyd extended this requirement to all containers in all trades.

Hapag-Lloyd E-Business

During the transition period, the CP Ships e-business activities will gradually be transferred from CP Ships' website to Hapag-Lloyd's. Upon completion of the migration for all trades, www.cpships.com will no longer be available.

In order to provide you with the e-solution that fits your business best, Hapag-Lloyd offers four different e-channels.

- **Bilateral EDI**
(a direct link between the HL and the customer's system used to exchange messages such as bookings, shipping instructions and tracing status)
- **INTTRA**
(a multi-carrier platform with uniform user interface for all participants)
- **hapag-lloyd.com** "online business"
(interactive features on our HL website)
- **e-mail solutions**
(specific shipment information sent automatically as e-mail)

These four e-channels cover all main functionalities such as Hapag-Lloyd services, tariffs, schedules, online booking (via Intra), online shipping instruction, export and import modules, tracing, Sea Waybill Download and e-invoice download.
