

■ China Chinese New Year Holiday – Operational Restrictions

Dear Customer,

Please be advised that in view of the forthcoming Chinese New Year Holiday from January 22 to January 28, 2012 there will be the following operational restrictions for import shipments to China :

South China (including Guangdong, Guangxi, Hainan and Yunan Province) :

- All inbound hazardous shipments will be prohibited from January 12 to January 28, 2012 for the following ports :

Hainan / Guangxi / Yunan and Pearl River Delta ports, including but not limited to Huangpu / Guangzhou / Foshan / Sanshui / Zhanjiang / Zhongshan / Zhuhai / Jiangmen / Shantou / Huizhou / Dongguan / Jiujiang / Nanhai / Rongqi / Shunde / Gaosha.

- Import operation remains unaffected for Shenzhen ports including Yantian / Shekou / Chiwan / Da Chan Bay.
- Feeder services serving Hainan, Guangxi and Pearl River Delta ports will be suspended from January 17 to January 30, 2012.

North China :

- DG Classes 1 and 7 restricted and not accepted for discharge between January 12 and January 28, 2012.

Any demurrage / detention incurred at transshipment ports will be for the account of cargo.
