

■ **EU Regulation 1875/2006 – Entry Summary Regulation (ENS)
Reminder Shipping Instructions**

June 1, 2011

Dear Customer,

Since **January 1, 2011** the security regulation of the European Union (EU) has been in effect.

The EU Commission has decided that all EU countries must terminate their individual grace period for transmission of ENS **June 30, 2011** at the latest.

Therefore, it is likely that Customs authorities will start issuing fines or vessels will encounter delays in the EU ports, if the security manifest data is not transmitted 24 hours prior to loading.

To avoid any of this all shipping instructions must be submitted according to the documentation cut-off time stipulated in the Hapag-Lloyd booking confirmation. Consequently, non-compliance may lead to cargo not being loaded on board the EU going vessel.

Furthermore please note that all information in the shipping instructions must be correct and complete, "Pro Forma" information is not acceptable.

In instances where penalties are received due to amendments requested by the customer after the security manifest transmission, Hapag-Lloyd will have no choice but to hold the customer responsible for any fines incurred.
