- Germany has 2 demurrage codes as follows:

- Import Demurrage (DMD) for containers at the Sea terminal. It includes Storages.

Calculation starts the day unit has been discharged from vessel and expires when unit gates out full from the Sea terminal.

- Import Inland Terminal Demurrage (DID) for containers at the inland terminal. It includes Storages.

Calculation starts at 00.01 the day after delivery of full unit at the inland terminal and expires with dispatchment of full unit.

A cranage fee of EUR 35,00 is charged per each container at the inland terminal for loading/unloading unit from the rail wagon, barge or chassis by crane.


** Detention Charges and Freetimes are applicable for Merchant's and Carrier's Haulage **MHD/DTD: Relevant for detention calculation is the tariff of the country where equipment has been returned.

In addition to the Demurrage & Detention tariffs this guideline will help you to understand when the Demurrage and/or Detention occurs.

Demurrage/ Detention in Merchant Haulage

Potential demurrage and/or detention will be charged to the cargo owner because the customer decides when to pick up the container. This will not be the carrier's responsibility.

Scenario 1: Pick up arranged as Merchant Haulage



Demurrage in Carriers Haulage


Port B/L: All potential Demurrage and/ or Detention will be for account of the cargo.

Door B/L: Case by case evaluation of delay reason

- Late submission of complete transport instructions by customer
- All transport instructions must be submitted to Hapag-Lloyd at least 3 business days before the vessel's estimated time of arrival (ETA). In case of bank holidays, the notice must be of 5 days. Complete transport instructions contain address, customs clearance details and special requirements (e.g. multi-stop, loading ref, delivery requirements, among others.)
- Customs inspections and interventions of State Authority / governmental organizations (e.g. but not limited to customs scan, physical inspection of goods, phytosanitary inspections by veterinary etc)
- Customs clearance (when performed by customer) not finalized at the time of planned pick up
- Cases of force majeure (e.g but not limited to Low water, Terminal operations' interruptions, strikes, war etc). Please refer to BL clause 18 related to "Matters affecting performance".

Please keep in mind that other scenarios not included in this list can lead to Demurrage and/or Detention.

Standard Containers include Standard High Cube
