The Shipper agrees to indemnify the Carrier, its servants, agents, the Vessel, her owner or (bareboat-) charterer, operator and the master, and to hold all of them harmless in respect of any liability, loss, damage or expense of whatsoever nature which may be sustained in relation to or in connection with any of the following, but not limited to any mis-declaration, insufficient securing, non-compliance of the Cargo, failure of the consignee to take delivery, re-export of the Cargo and/or disposal of the Cargo.
4. It is agreed that these warranties, responsibilities and the indemnities are given in addition to and shall not in any way limit the Shipper's liability under the contract of affreightment and Carrier's Bill of Lading and/or Sea Waybill Terms and Conditions.
