Please refer to the above subject and the request letter and documents submitted by you in this regard.

Documents submitted by you through email have been perused by the undersigned and the fact that you have been granted the DIT Relief Certificate for the said vessels for FY 2019-20, has also been considered.

However due to outbreak of the pandemic Covid-19 virus, there is severe disruption in the normal working of almost all the sectors, including the functioning of the Income Tax Department. In such a scenario, it is not possible to give you a physical certificate at present.
