

Gemini Cooperation - Japan Shuttle service (revised 4)

Dear Valued Customers,

As announced early this year, the Gemini Cooperation operations will start from February 2025. Therefore, we would like to share with you the details of the shuttle service between Japan and Shanghai, which will be the hub port of the Gemini service to and from Japan.

In the following table, you will find the port coverage, yard and documentation cutoffs and the estimated arrival (ETA) and departure (ETD) days.
