

■ China – Ministry of Transport (MOT) Regulation on Road Transportation

Dear Customer,

We would like to inform you that the Ministry of Transport in People's Republic of China has introduced a new regulation with respect to length, height and weight limitations for road transportation. This regulation is effective from **September 21, 2016**. The regulation by the authorities written in English and Chinese are available with this letter. Please be advised and the information is for your necessary action, where required.

Please obtain the necessary permissions as required by the regulation before arranging transportation to pick up empties from the nominated depots and returning of the laden to terminals.

For bookings under carrier haulage, please note the time line required to obtain the permission from the Authorities. Bookings and empty pick-up requirements must be aligned with the regulations.

For import containers under carrier haulage, consignee must also provide the final door address in accordance with the time line. Our Customer Service Import Department will contact the consignee accordingly. The necessary permissions will be applied for through our trucking company while arranging carrier haulage.

Hapag-Lloyd will not be responsible for any costs and/or penalties arising out of non-compliance of this new regulation.
