Adelaide, South Australia - Changes in Terminal Handling Charges

Dear Customer,

Please be informed that as a result of a Channel widening project in the Port of Adelaide, Flinders ports have increased the **Channel dredging levy** for the container trade to facilitate this initiative.

The Channel widening project will allow for larger vessels to call the Port of Adelaide in the near future, and thereby assist in improved service to ocean carriers and the trade.

As a result of this development, Hapag-Lloyd will increase the **Terminal Handling charges** (Origin and Destination) in Adelaide as noted below, with effect from Monday, January 21, 2019.
