

■ **Thailand – Import to Bangkok Port via Laem Chabang**

January 23, 2014

Dear Customer,

Please be informed that with effect from **February 15, 2014** all inbound cargoes to Bangkok (THBKK) will be routed via Laem Chabang (THLCH) by barge service.

In the import document, please insert Port of Discharge as Laem Chabang.

Additionally, we wish to remind you that the Port Authority of Thailand stipulates that all importers are required to fill in a Dangerous Cargo declaration 24 hours prior to vessel arrival at Laem Chabang port via the website:

If there is missing information in the Dangerous Cargo declaration, the Port Authority of Thailand at Laem Chabang will not discharge the container and have it retained on board where additional charges will be incurred. In cases of late submission of Dangerous Cargo declaration via the website, the Laem Chabang Port will impose a penalty charge on the importer at THB 50,000 and other operational costs may also be incurred.
