

■ Thailand – Export Documentation Amendment Fee

Dear Customer,

In October this year, Hapag-Lloyd provided a structural extension to the time window for the submission of your Shipping Instruction (SI) prior to vessel arrival at load port. This additional time allowance has been granted to assist you in providing accurate and complete details.

However, there are still requests for amendments to SI details being made after the initial submission and accordingly, we would like to inform you we will change the way documentation amendment fees are applied.

Effective **January 15, 2013** all customer-initiated amendments requested after submission of the initial SI will be subject to a **Documentation Amendment Fee (MAF)** of:

■ THB 600 per amended Shipping Instruction

To enable an accurate and complete shipping instruction, we kindly ask you to submit the shipping instruction as close as possible to the advised documentation cut-off time. Please do not send a shipping instruction which is not complete.

All amendments for advanced manifest destinations which are received within 24 hours of vessel arrival at the load port will still be subject to the Security Manifest Change Fee (SMC), currently being applied. Late amendments may also be subject to Customs fines.
