

- Many Customers may get confused when it comes to filling info in Electronic Advanced Shipping Instruction ( **EASI** ) form.
- **Scenario (1)**: someone who wants to add only '*DG information*' for the same container without reflecting them in the wrong place.
- **Scenario (2)**: someone who wants to add an '*Extra Container*' in general after exceeding number of containers allowed within the file.

**-Scenario(1):** someone who wants to add only **'DG information'** for the same container without reflecting them in the wrong place.

-After filling the information needed regarding **'Non-DG'** cargo, you can simply press **'Add'** Cargo for the same container to add **'DG'** cargo info. Hence, you will find out that both info were added for the same container number as shown below :



In conclusion, there will be two cargoes number (1) **'Non-DG'** cargo & number (2) **'DG'** cargo info were added for the same container.

**-Scenario (2):** someone who wants to add an 'Extra Container' in general after exceeding number of containers allowed within the file.

-As known that the maximum number of containers to be added is ( 50 containers ) in every EASI form. Hence, to add an extra container within the same file, you can simply click 'Add' Container as shown in below picture:

In conclusion, after pressing 'Add' Container, there will be another container added within the same EASI form like container number (51, 52, 53, ..... etc.).
