Gemini Cooperation: Hapag-Lloyd will leave THE Alliance and team up with Maersk


- A long-term agreement has been signed with Maersk and will start in February 2025

- We will return to the Red Sea when it is safe to do so







- The EME service will be an alternative to EMX for cargo from the Marmara region and Aliaga..






EME Service Update:
