- 5. MO41 certificate to be sent separately to <u>Australia@service.hlag.com</u> or <u>Newzealand@service.hlag.com</u>

**Note:** we will continue to accept manual Haz bookings up until 1<sup>st</sup> June 2022. Manual bookings fees of AUD150/ booking for Australia & USD 150 /NZ will be applicable.
