**Special Cargo: include but not limit to -
• Meat of bovine animals, fresh or chilled - Carcasses and half-carcasses
• Flours, meals and pellets, of meat or meat offal, offish or of crustaceans, molluscs or other aquatic invertebrates, unfit for human consumption; greaves- Flours, meals and pellets, of fish or of crustaceans, molluscs or other aquatic invertebrates
• Marble, travertine, ecaussine and other calcareous monumental or building stone of an apparent specific gravity of 2,5 or more, and alabaster, whether or not roughly trimmed or merely cut, by sawing or otherwise, into blocks or slabs of a rectangular(including square) shape - Marble and travertine –Crude or
• Other ores and concentrates - Antimony ores and concentrates
• Other inorganic acids and other inorganic oxygen compounds of non-metals - Other inorganic acids --Hydrogen fluoride (hydrofluoric acid)
• Paints and varnishes (including enamels and lacquers) based on synthetic polymers or chemically modified natural polymers, dispersed or dissolved ina non-aqueous medium; solutions as defined in note 4to this chapter
• Dextrins and other modified starches (for example.pregelatinised or esterified starches); glues based on starches, or on dextrins or other modified starches - Dextrins and other modified starches
• Polymers of propylene or of other olefins, in primary forms - Polypropylene
• Natural polymers (for example, alginic acid) and modified natural polymers (for example, hardened proteins, chemical derivatives of natural rubber).not elsewhere specified or included, in primary forms - Other
• Raw hides and skins of bovine (including buffalo) orequine animals (fresh, or salted, dried, limed, pickled or otherwise preserved, but not tanned, parchment-dressed or further prepared), whether or not dehaired or split - Whole hides and skins, unsplit, of a weight per skin not exceeding 8 when simply dried,
• Tanned or crust hides and skins of bovine (including buffalo) or equine animals, without hair on, whether or not split, but not further prepared - In the wetstate (including wet-blue) -- Full grains, unsplit; grain splits

• Tanned or crust hides and skins of other animals, without wool or hair on, whether or not split, but not further prepared - Of goats or kids -- In the wet state (including wet-blue)
• Tanned or crust hides and skins of other animals, without wool or hair on, whether or not split, but not further prepared - Of swine -- In the wet state(including wet-blue)
• Tanned or crust hides and skins of other animals, without wool or hair on, whether or not split, but not further prepared - Other -- In the wet state(including wet-blue)
• Leather further prepared after tanning or crusting, including parchment-dressed leather, of bovine(including buffalo) or equine animals, without hair on, whether or not split, other than leather of heading 4114 - Whole hides and skins -- Full grains, unsplit
• Trunks, suitcases, vanity cases, executive-cases, briefcases, school satchels, spectacle cases, binocular cases, camera cases, musical instrument cases, gun cases, holsters and similar containers; travelling-bags, insulated food or beverages bags, toilet bags, rucksacks, handbags, shopping-bags, wallets,

• Chemical wood pulp, soda or sulphate, other than dissolving grades - Semi-bleached or bleached --Non-coniferous
• Worked monumental or building stone (except slate)and articles thereof, other than goods of heading 6801; mosaic cubes and the like, of natural stone (including slate), whether or not on abacking; artificially coloured granules, chipping sand powder, of natural stone (including slate) -Other -- Marble, travertine
