

Implementation of Haulier Weight Restrictions at Port Klang – Effective May 1, 2025

Dear Valued Customer,

Effective May 1, 2025, the Port Klang Authority (PKA) will enforce new weight restrictions on hauliers exceeding the Combined Vehicle Weight (BGK) to minimize road damage, enhance safety, and reduce maintenance costs.

Key Implementation Details

- **Import Transactions**: All bookings will be verified at the booking stage. If the total load exceeds the BGK, the booking will be rejected.
- **Export Transactions**: Vehicles will be weighed at the port entrance. Hauliers exceeding the BGK limit three times will be denied entry into the port.
- **BGK Calculation**: The BGK includes the combined weight of the haulier, trailer, and container's Verified Gross Mass (VGM).
- **Haulier Responsibilities**: Haulage operators are fully aware of these limitations and should advise their customers accordingly.
- System-Based Monitoring: All weight checks will be automated, with blacklisting managed by PKA & MOT.
- **Customer Advisory**: Overloading, especially in back-to-back haulage, should be avoided to ensure compliance.
