Welcome on board - 77 new trainees start their careers with Hapag-Lloyd

Today 77 young talents start their maritime careers with Hapag-Lloyd in Hamburg. Some of the

trainees will learn traditional nautical professions: 13 ship mechanics, 15 nautical assistant officers

and 1 technical officer's assistant will be trained as seafarers. A further 21 trainees will learn shore-

based professions such as shipping clerk.

Another 14 ship mechanics already started their training at the beginning of the year and are currently

on their first voyage with the "Chicago Express". The 8,600 TEU ship is one of two Hapag-Lloyd

training ships and is currently sailing in Atlantic Loop 6 (AL6) from Southern Europe to the US East

Administration and the Nordakademie, who are pursuing bachelor's degrees in International

Management, Logistics Management, Business Information Systems and Applied Computer

Science.
